FROM THE MINISTER

Last night I got back from New Orleans and four days of helping out around the house for my mother. My sisters, brother and I will have painted the front porch, replaced the front door and helped clean a place in the new room (added over 45 years ago).

Having projects to do and the satisfaction of completing them is part of purposeful living. This goes on in our everyday living and at the church. The Property Ministry group has an ongoing list of things we are going to do soon or when we have enough help and time. Some of the projects we are hoping to complete is the office restroom where new lighting, sink and hot water is being added. We are remodeling both the Fellowship Classroom and the McCarver Hospitality Room. Both rooms will get new flooring and furniture. The chapel conference room is ready for new baseboard molding and electrical outlets. And the sanctuary will see a repair on the center aisle flooring and possibly new flooring under the choir to enhance our sound movement. The biggest change will come in adding 8 big screen monitors along the side arches and ending the use of the big screen on the chancel. The Blessing of the Screens is tentatively set for the first Sunday in October. Having a schedule for any project is in part what gets things done. If Aunty Sally is coming for a visit on a certain date, we will work hard to make sure our home is ready when she arrives. The church needs the same kind of target date or it is too easy to get sidetracked. Emergencies tend to zap our strength and put off our schedules. But what makes for completions is having enough volunteers and the funds to pay for contractors to get things done. If you would like to help, talk to Steve Gray, Roger Moore or Dick Losee. And be sure to continue to be encouraging of those who are working on our projects. Also volunteer to serve on our Property Ministry group as we set new goals.
