Pastoral Needs—If you would like to speak with the pastor, please feel free to meet at the door after worship service or call during business hours, 951-686-0646.

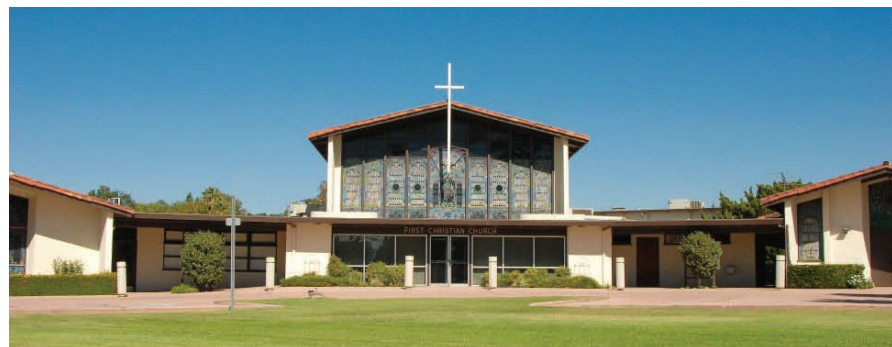
