FROM THE MINISTER

We have had the big screen in worship for 12 years now and it served us well but it is sort-of obnoxious. The ability to see the words on a big screen helped many and the use of pictures for funerals has always been appreciated. Also we have used it for short videos on special occasions. Shortly after we added it, we hosted the Regional Assembly and it worked great with a large crowd. But it changed the way we see the beauty of the sanctuary. It was the elephant in the room that we did see. So when we first began using it in worship, we always limited its use to the first half of the service. We have had many volunteers who organized the words to enhance our worship. The last who took on this responsibility was Kathy and then Mike Rader. We appreciated their time and talents when they were in worship. And when they were not available, we didn't use it.

Since Easter Sunday we began using the big screen all the way through worship. And for the last month we have added a 46 inch HDTV along the pillar side of the sanctuary to get a glimpse of an overall plan to replace the big screen. Many have commented on being able to see the smaller screen better. Why is it? Part of it is the way outside light diminished the screen's image. Depending on the time of the day this can be dramatic. Also as technology advances, the projectors have become lighter, brighter and cheaper.

Our plan is the add six HDTV's for those in the pews and two for those leading worship. The bid was higher than we first thought and since then we have been able to trim it by two thirds. The plan is to complete the installation by the end of August. In the meantime we have invited Shannon Kimbell Auth to lead us in a one day training event on July 1st. Shannon brings her skills in adapting themes and images to worship. We are interested in the skills needed to use images in a powerful way in worship.

A training event will be held on Friday, July 1st from about 5-9 PM event with an afternoon training for ministers in adapting message to screen. We are all invited, just let us know so we can have enough food. Following installation we will do training on the computer software that will utilize our skills and imagination.
