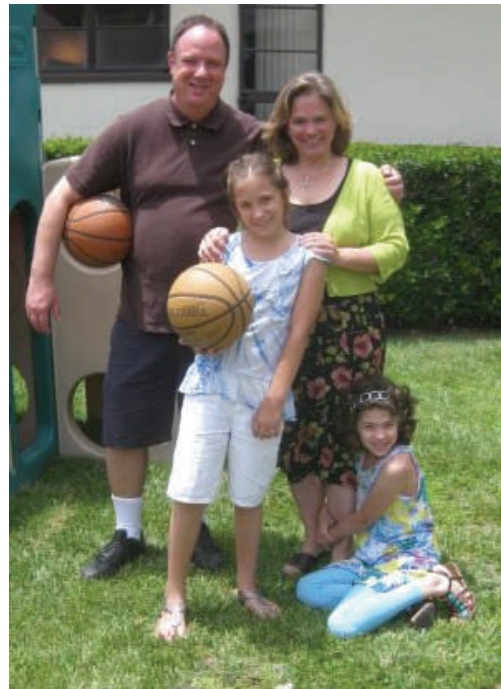

FROM THE MINISTER

About two weeks ago I was digging up the grass in my back yard to prepare for new sod. I was using a new pick axe and getting pretty good at swinging it. But along the concrete slab I made a mistake and got too close, striking the slab, which diverted the blade to my left foot. It took a gouge out of the shoe, sock and my skin all at once. I was quick to see the damage and it didn't look bad but it sure hurt. I was more careful from then on and didn't hit myself again. But then about four days later, I noticed that my whole foot was bruised from my heel to toes. And now ten days later, it still looks bad but it's getting better.

When I think back over my experiences in life, the most pain I have ever felt, was caused by myself not by others. My carelessness and poor choices were most often the cause of pain in my life. I would like to believe it was someone else's fault but I know the truth. Some of us have had terrible things happen to us that were not our fault. We have been taken advantage of, abused and hurt in deep ways. But many more of us have no one to blame but ourselves.

We have to recognize the difference between what we have done to ourselves and what others have done to us. Some of us can forgive others before they can forgive themselves. Others are more gracious to themselves than others. Faith is about how we live with hurts and how God helps us to heal after we have been hurt. Let's make sure, we make room for those who are still having trouble forgiving and healing.
