**FROM THE MINISTER**

**Chris C. Nettles**

We will be taking a special offering on April 3rd toward those in need in Japan. FCC's Outreach will match dollar for dollar what we give in the offering. It will be sent through Week of Compassion as we work in partnership with the United Church of Christ in Japan. Also our offering will be added to Church World Service and its member communions who are already providing emergency relief support to at least 5,000 families (25,000 people) now living at 100 evacuation sites in the northeastern area of Japan (Miyagi, Fukushima, Iwate, Ibaragi, Tochigi prefectures). Assistance at these sites is being delivered through a partnership with the Japan Platform, an alliance of 32 humanitarian organizations who have come together to respond to the emergency. CWS is focusing on evacuation sites where the basic needs for food, water, sanitation, electricity and fuel are not being met. The need for clean drinking water and blankets are being prioritized to help protect people from the cold. In order to maintain radio contact at evacuation sites, batteries will be supplied, enabling survivors to receive vital news, especially on nuclear radiation-related developments. Gas and fuel supplies will also be sent to evacuation sites.

While monetary gifts are the most effective and immediate way to respond to the crises in Japan, CWS hygiene kits would also be appreciated. The kits that were already sent to Japan were those pre-positioned in our CWS warehouses in the region. They will need to be re-stocked.
